Handover of the "Dam Project"

On the 18th August 2013, property owners and the members of the Still Creek Landcare Group met in Arcadia to hand back the regeneration works on the 2



neighbouring properties for the future care by their owners.

The aim of the project was to strengthen the wildlife corridor

between Berowra Valley National Park and Marramarra National Park, by reducing the spread of privet and other weeds along the creek and to improve the condition of the native vegetation on the site.



The planning began in mid 2010 and grand

funding was obtained in early 2011. The works involved clearing privet, blackberry, honeysuckle and other invasive weeds, erect temporary wallaby fencing and planting 550 eucalypts, turpentines and wattles. The young native trees had been grown by the volunteers of the Hornsby Shire Council Community Nursery, from seed locally collected.

The site was maintained for 2 years, with monthly maintenance weed removal and 2 watering working bees after planting. Many of the trees are now 2 to 3 metres high and growing well.

The site will now only need occasional maintenance, just enough to stop privet and other weeds to re-establish. Native grasses, ferns and groundcovers are already established at the site and will help to stop the weeds emerging.
