Once again, a generous donor has enabled Landcare to offer free local native plants to landowners who live in Hornsby Council's rural area, or Hills Shire along Old Northern Road or close to it. Plants have previously gone to people who are doing a great job on their properties by clearing privet or lantana or other weeds, often along creeks. Some people are revegetating their roadside nature strip or creating a wildlife corridor.

These donated plants are local natives and so are ideal for revegetating the cleared areas. You can't buy local native plants from retail nurseries, so this is a special opportunity. The plants are top quality.

I will help you work out what plants would be suitable for your site from the list of plants that are currently available from 2 Nurseries. I will then advise them to expect a call from you to organise a visit. For Hornsby Shire residents, the plants will come from the Community Nursery at Pennant Hills. For Hills Shire residents, the plants will come from Bunya Native Nursery at Dural. The minimum number of plants will be 1 tray of 40 tubes. Trays and tubes are to be returned to the Nurseries or to me when you have finished with them.
